

DEMOCRACY

1. Preamble

Before I start, I'd like to state that at all times each state's law is dominant.

A society without rules is only possible if all the people are love full and take care of each other then there are no criminals, no bullies, and no laws are necessary, **but where is that?** Freedom without rules is anarchy, every social society needs an basic or common set of rules enforced by leaders or government. 2. Studies

Taboo of the Democracy.

The bureaucracy is a multiplayer-game in which people have made their career by collecting and use of bureaucratic power. It rewards often useless good-for-nothing and prestige. It rewards persons by roll off (back down) of mistakes, collecting information, often say NO to collaboration and concentrating to his own task. It rewards persons who are good in reading the gravity of their boss and understand the prejudice of their leaders but not of their own competency. Lots of time is spend on political manoeuvring with high invisible costs. The bureaucrats acting with dogma's and mantra's in which inaccurate opinions stay in position. Their thinking speed and opinion change stays far behind the reality.

The Law of Parkinson.

Without state of war, in a bureaucratic organisation the number of labourers will rise 5% - 7% each year, independent if the work stays the same, decreases or complete disappears!

The Humanocracy (by Gary Hamel USA)

The tyranny of the bureaucracy is an always growing toxic process. The power and strategy lies by positions of leaders down to the managers with long time during approval, and with a rule-killing management system. The human element is driven out to make the system rational as a machine with a force control over the people. There is no "Delete" button to remove this form of the bureaucracy. **The bureaucracy should be an assistant for the people!**

The Meritocracy.

Is to be government by those whom deserve it based on their merits. Non model is the fixed solution but principals can been inspired by other progressives. It is an ongoing process and evolution to try new ideas. Their voice is the base for the new organisations.

The Gerontocracy.

A gerontocracy is a form of oligarchical rule in which an entity is ruled by leaders who are significantly older than most of the adult population. By Plato "it is for the elder man to rule and for the younger to submit". The best example of this can be seen in the ancient Greek state city of Sparta, which was ruled by a Gerousia. A Gerousia was a council made up of members who were at least 60 years old and served for life.

Pornocracy

Is a government ruled by prostitutes or by corrupt officials who metaphorically "prostitute" themselves for power. Saeculum obscurum, a period in the Catholic Church often referred to as "pornocracy".

Purocracy (by Piet Bogaards NL)

Is an government without parties and based on making concessions. So there is no fight for the leadership in the party or for the government.

Social involvement

Without discrimination and in all the different race of humans there are people with different social involvement based on its behavior:

- Barbarian, are rough, hard, uncivilized, insensitive without awareness of moral values, or without taste or feeling. It is a cruelty without compassion in thought and action.
- Proletarian, has a low degree of compassion for his immediate surroundings as a spouse and family. His compassion for society is limited to his self-interest.
- Ordinaire, small, every day and ordinary. It is the proletarian with a slightly higher degree of compassion for his immediate surroundings and his society.
- Extra ordinaire, is a very normal person. Who consciously does what he thinks he should do, no more and no less. He has a higher compassion for the society and nature. He can achieve great achievements on a particular subject, if this satisfies his personal need.
- Civil, is a person with ordinary politeness or courtesy. A civil person is not insensitive or indifferent or lethargic to psychic stimuli, urges and passion of a pursuit of something. He is aware of the rules between them; obligations and rights arising therefrom. He is not passive, actively participates in society and in the process of changing society. His voice is not lost, he is not apathetic to politics. The apathy is the degree of being jaded or numb.
- Intellectuals use all their spiritual intellectual abilities to understand all human aspirations and urges. The intellectual possesses the gift of intellectual understanding of nature and worldview. They are the generators and custodians of culture, the spiritual elite. They are gifted with knowledge and insight.

Very low conscious to almost unconscious are the children and people who cannot have absorbed anything in life due to their congenital mental disability. A mentally disabled is the partial functioning of human functions, due to disorder or defect due to an illness, condition, accident or congenital. The degree of this depends on the degree of disability. Mentally disabled people live in moderation, unconsciously with their limited reason and more according to instinct and feeling.

In the Democracy everyone is having the right to vote there leaders and representative members in government, regardless there reasons and irrespective of party. The votes are on not trackable to the person whom made its vote.

The reasons from a person to vote on someone is different, it can be on its content of coals, it can be because its parents always vote for him or its party, it can be because his face is often in the publicity, it can be its sympathy face or does the voter think that there is a profit for him after the person is elected.

So there are a lot of reasons for one to vote on an person even it have nothing to do with the elected capacities in its function. And sometimes when one is elected they refuse to take the job and only participate to support its party. And when one is in office its coals are not coming in practical results. What the coals me be, they are depending on the will and co-operate of others but above all the financial possibilities.

Even before one goes in office there is an battle in the party for its position as party leader and/or coming on the list to be elected. And in office the battel for positions and coals continues.

3. The Humancracy

In 2007 I wrote four little books (Dutch) in a novel series "The Planet Rookie" and they were no bestsellers, but the subject in one of my books about the floating city with a different form of government has my attention again.

Is it possible to have a government without battles between parties? Is it possible to have representatives based on its capacities, potency and knowledge?

Formed by study over the Democracy, observing the taboos, reconsidering, and by logical reasoning I am the founder of "**The Humancracy**".

It is mine personal idea of a good and new form of social-humane government.

The Humancracy is including the Codex Homo Sapiens (HS) and with the Traject-hierarchy.

The Humancracy is the evolution of the Democracy into democratically layers.

The Humancracy is a social-humane government.

The Codex is for the universal duties and rights of each human.

The Traject-hierarchy is for each human without discrimination and based on its capacities.

Each group and level is a Purocracy based on group concession.

As a fulltime Utopian and Aquapreneur I like to awake people about this subjects by the website <https://www.utopist.nl> and I will organize information gatherings. The goal is to found a society under the name Aquapreneur and to start the building of the Floating City UTOPIA one of the futures. See website <https://aquapreneur.nl>

The Society Aquapreneur is a society of **post-material natural persons** with its the shared goals:

- To implement the Humancracy with the Codex Homo Sapiens and the Traject-hierarchy.
- Accessible by contract.
- Disqualification of barbarians and bullies.
- Financial neutral management with its own value, without exchange rates.
- Start the building of the floating city UTOPIA and its expansions.
- To manage the common possession of the floating city UTOPIA including the buildings.
- Working together with other aquapreneurs and organisations.
- Collecting, saving, and distributing of knowledge.
- To enable the primary and secondary needs of life.
- To enable to provide additional products and services (P&S).
- To make it possible for members to make products and to deliver services (P&S).
- To make it possible for members to build personal capital and their possessions.

4. The Traject-hierarchy

The Humancracy is the evolution of the Democracy in layers. The Humancracy is with a Codex Homo Sapiens and a personal Traject-hierarchy. The goal is that every person can develop and self-realize in society.

The Humancracy connects personal freedom with its social responsibility by following the (stage) Traject-hierarchy. The Traject-hierarchy makes it possible for each person to come to a position that fits with its capacity or potential and its ambition to grow up in the Traject-hierarchy of the Humancracy of its community. In a layer each group of persons is an Purocratie and (business) decisions are without a fighting but with discussions.

The personal Traject-hierarchy makes it **possible** for any person to reach a position because:

- The Traject-hierarchy is a self-regulating system of advice and responsibility of each layer.
- Dominance is the duty-bound cooperation in the same number of persons belonging to each layer.
- The personal responsibility is partial and decisions are made in a democratic way.
- One person in a group is the representative out of the next layer.

The position for the **next layer** in the Traject-hierarchy is **possibly** characterised by:

- The personal autonomy in acting
- The level of civil character accents.
- The level of compassion.
- Their personal capacities.
- These factors are observed, valued and advised by the next level and judged by the second next level.

The personal Traject-hierarchy makes it **impossible** to reach a position through:

- Pressure, intimidation,
- Verbal or physical force by bullies or narcist.
- Self-improvement, self-glorifying.
- Financial input of power.
- Provided service in the past.
- Publically famous, public function.
- Prejudiced in favour, prepossession, arbitrariness, nomination.
- Civil arrangement, by marriage, family reunion, origin of birth.
- Or by passing through time.

Short description of the Layers

As a civilian in any Society as well as a member of the Society Aquapreneur and in the Floating City UTOPIA is a member of the first three layers.

- The first layer is the adult person and is solely responsible for all its acting.
- The second layer exists of two companions both acting together in work or communication. So as to take care of and protect each other. Talk about daily matters. Don't think alone! Open your mind to other opinions so you will not be imprisoned by your own mind and you no longer will live in a bubble.
- The third layer is a group of three persons who are interested in a subject or work for a common goal.

In the Society Aquapreneur and in the City UTOPIA the membership starts after you have studied the Humancracy, the principal statement, the Codex Homo Sapiens, the Traject-hierarchy and have signed to accept the rules by contract. By the Society Aquapreneur the task for each layer is arranged in the principle statement.

- The fourth layer is a group of four persons whose work or goal will be decided by the organisation.
- The fifth layer exists of the mentors and observation the new members.
- The sixth layer exists of the watchmen
- The seventh layer exists of the government
- The eighth layer exists of the judges
- The ninth layer exists of the ideologies

5. The Codex Homo Sapiens

This Codex is open for discussion build on arguments by progress in new insights through time. It is a Codex for the universal duties and rights of each human in its growth to adulthood. The awakening and transferring of the responsibility from the parents to someone's own responsibility is going smoothly in different phases. Depending of its culture, intelligence, mental and physical development, each phase takes about seven years.

Basic idea is that a human **first** has to fulfil its duties, and **after that** they can shamelessly ask for all the fitting rights. **No more, no less!**

The foetus, in the first period of 120 days after missing the menstruation is by a not wished pregnancy to be stopped. After this period a human is growing and the soul will in the next or last period be incarnated and the foetus has all rights to be protected by anybody during its growth and birth.

The first live phase till 7 years is a baby and toddler without obligations but with rights on food, clothing, bed, play, and to learn on directions by loving parents for a safe behaviour.

The second live phase till 14 years is a child. Now follows the awaking of its personality, its social behaviour and its body development for reproduction.

The third live phase till 21 years is a young adult in its growth to independence.

Primary necessities of life are the need of: breath, food, reproduction, rest and protection from the weather. Failure to foresee or otherwise abstain from any of these elements leads to early death. The primary task of the community and every citizen is to ensure this.

Secondary necessities of life are social contact, equality, relaxation, education, communication, law and a measure of happiness as well as the pursuit of happiness. The unforeseen or other abstinence of one of these elements results in a decrease in the sense of life and/or happiness in life. It is therefore the task of the community and every citizen that every individual can strive to achieve this.

Additional necessities of life are personal property, luxury, fashion, holidays, sports and art. The unforeseen or other abstinence of one of these elements results in a limitation of happiness in life, which does not entail damage to life. It is therefore the task of the community and every citizen that every individual can strive to achieve this in balance with the interests of society. Personal property comes from its labour.

About human-to-human help.

If it does **not concern life-saving help or to prevent danger**, everyone may impose conditions on its help.

- There is no obligation to provide assistance.
- Everyone has the right to refuse help, obstacles are enough to refuse.
- The care provider determines whether the aid contributes to the set goal.
- The care provider determines the method of help, even if the person requesting assistance wishes otherwise.

Regarding help from the city Utopia to another community or individuals.

- Humanitarian aid is without residence rights or other rights.
- The aid is aimed as temporary support until it continues independently and without assistance.
- Aid will never lead to structural dependence.

The city Utopia or a group can provide temporary help for:

- services
- protection
- housing
- food and clothing

The city Utopia has no obligation to other groups or individuals for:

- Personal subsidies.

- Provide labour and/or additions to provide necessities of life.
- Prevent them from harming themselves or taking risks.

Advocacy in law.

Concerning jurisdiction in the city Utopia:

- From injuries or crimes committed by an individual or group, the injured person or group cannot derive any other right than restoration and sentencing of the perpetrator to punishment.
- The sentence should be heavier than the damage that has been caused.
- The manner in which evidence has been obtained in a crime cannot be derived from it to destroy the evidence.
- The manner in which the burden of proof has been obtained must be assessed independently in relation to the crime.
- Utopia's laws should be subordinate to the conscience of administrators and judges.
- Laws serve as tools for equal treatment and assessment in equal cases

Work and capital.

Each person will do labour for living and P&S. There are different forms of work.

- Work, without people asking for it, stays without payment, you do something because you feel you need to do it, you are acting out of love.
- Work after people have asked for it but in advance have agreed that there will no payment is voluntary work which gives satisfaction and respect.
- Work asked for by the Society Aquapreneur, is a part of your contribution and is not payable with money.
- Work, which is asked for, gives a reasonable or fair reward in relation with its layer of Traject-hierarchy with money.

The earned money is free to spend, well knowing that the membership also has costs which are to be paid by the members. The membership of the Society Aquapreneur consists of conscription of labour and regular payment of money. Members have the right to use: services, knowledge, personal development, and if the city UTOPIA is formed with available accommodation then each member has the right to live and work on the city UTOPIA.

Profit and capital

Members of the city UTOPIA, after having paid their contribution, have the right on life needs, staying and work. Money is the general means for change deserved by labour to buy P&S. Cumulated money is someone's capital. Each member on the city UTOPIA must live free of guilt. The personal capital is only coming out of labour, this is to prevent that someone tries to buy P&S, rights, or membership by bringing in money by the richest people or organisations. All personal capital is during its life free to spend, after its death it goes to the Society Aquapreneur as written in the principal statement "The contract" and signed by the acceptance as member.

6. Power

Pyramid of power as is present in the Western societies

- The base, are the people with or without work.
- The governments of the village, country, state, nation or united states.
- Multinational firms.
- Bankers.
- Dominated by the richest with the big amounts of money and who are not elected.

Pyramid of power in the city UTOPIA

The Society Aquapreneur is a federation of natural persons. The power is represented by each person in its position in the Traject-hierarchy. There is no competition for any position but each position is based on its capacities by electing in his group on turn for some degree of time.

Profit and growth

On the city UTOPIA the interest of P&S and the collective possession must stay in control with the members instead through a group of outsiders of the richest elite with their cumulated capital.

Distribution of power by money is only permitted by the members. The production of money is only by the Society Aquapreneur and not as in the Western societies by bankers. Fictive money is given by a bank loan contract which becomes real money for the bank though a pay back by the worker out of its earned money.

Earned money from labour becomes everyone's profit. Profit exists because loss exists. Everyone has the right to make a profit and at the same time the right to loss. The loss is the energy that was not necessary to archive the goal. Loss is energy waste in all its forms. Loss is buying of not necessary P&S. Loss is an illusion and stimulation of the need to buy P&S, by that as Las Vegas is built on the illusion and stimulation of gamblers to win the grand price.

Profit follows from labour by making products and delivering of services(P&S). Profit is possible if the buyer pays the required price to the maker of P&S. This profit makes growth now possible for each person and its society.

Not willing to pay the requested price reduces the profit and at the same time the growth. This situation is now visible in societies where lots of the population fights daily for the primary and secondary life needs and because of their egos they have full attention for themselves. Their ego together with personal possession comes first, the state economy stays on a lower level with little or no progress.

In Western societies the opposite is now often present and the economy is boosted.

If the primary and secondary life-needs are present there will be room for additional P&S to buy. In the Western societies we are constantly stimulated to buy P&S even it is not necessary, but it gives satisfaction to possess it. It is the basis for the consumer society. Buy this, buy that! Keep buying, then the economy will keep growing! The need is created in a professional way! Yet, the creation is part of the market named marketing.

It is an art to tempt someone to buy things they do not need, or are useless. The population is tempted to make losses!

If for P&S is advertised, do not buy it! Do not buy to get discounts! Buy only if you really need it!

Society Aquapreneur has the goal to create an economy based on the natural need to live a loving full life together and is not influenced by the elite with big capital and marketing.

7. Monetary The VELT currency

VELT is an acronym for the words: **V**alue **E**conomic **L**abour **T**ime and is symbolized with the increment sign Δ . The increment is what is added to anything, which increases its size.

VELT is the currency value for working time with an economic interest for the members of the Society Aquapreneur. VELT is the interchangeable currency for members obtained through labour in the production of goods and the provision of services.

Other kinds of working hours or types of work, which cannot be expressed in a currency, are out of selflessness such as: voluntary work, offering sacrifices in the interest of society or loving actions to other people.

The VELT currency Δ is covered by the Society Aquapreneur with:

- common assets, the floating elements
- common assets, on the floating elements buildings and properties
- common assets, of precious metals
- supplying labour by the members
- confidence in the organization

The currency VELT is the interchangeable money created by members, created solely by labour of economic interest. The value of the money is obtained exclusively through labour!

This is in contrast to other currencies which are created by banks with their fictitious issue of loans. The accounting money created by the bank is repaid by the borrower in real money. Banks do not use their own capital to issue loans! The money is not linked to precious metals or other assets, but to the trust of the people that the money is well covered. However, it has no more value than the paper it is printed on and above all a lot of confidence!

Système international d'unités Bureau international des poids et mesures in Sèvres. According to the SI-system, unit of time is the second, the other time indications are not according to the decimal SI-system, but have their origin in history with the 24 hours a day. Generally in every society, the hour is used as working time, linked to a decimal currency. Different currencies can be converted to each other with a factor that can change at any time.

The VELT currency is not linked to any other currency, but excludes the P&S working hours of the members of the Society Aquapreneur for his personal expenses within the Society Aquapreneur and on the floating city of UTOPIA.

The basic allowance of one working hour on the day (06-18h) depends on the level someone has in the Traject-hierarchy of Humancracy. Members begin in the fourth layer with a compensation for a P&S work hour with a basic fee. Each successive layer the hour working fee increased to a maximum working hour fee in the 9th layer. Work in the evening (18-24h) and in the night (00-06h) a additional factor can be allocated by the board or government.

Because the compensation is linked to the Traject-hierarchy of the Humancracy, everyone is valued on their capacities and cannot exceed the maximum compensation. This is in contrast to Western societies where exorbitant compensation exceeds all borders and is therefore considered unacceptable.

The payment in VELT consists of coins and debt notes, obligati notes or banknotes. The coins are made of one or more metals of different sizes in diameter, and "the obverse side" with an image and date of issue and period of validity with the reverse side "the coin side" indicating the value Δ .

The banknote with the value in Δ , unique code, name and signed by the representative, the year of issue and the period of validity, images or creative expressions, and with security features.

The period of validity of the coin and banknote have the purpose of making counterfeiting senseless and in addition, not all coins and banknotes issued will be exchanged for new ones. The currency after the period of validity will be destroyed by the Society Aquapreneur and can no longer be accepted or exchanged by the Society Aquapreneur and has thus become income for the common cash. By the members collected coins and banknotes can increase in value because it will have a collectible value over time for the members and thus contribute to its personal capital.

Monetary policy means the sum of measures that a Central Bank can take to keep the value of its own currency stable. Two types of value can be distinguished with regard to a currency: the inner value, the purchasing power, and the external value the exchange rate. Monetary policy therefore consists of two parts, the money policy and the exchange rate policy.

Society Aquapreneur money policy is based on the inner value of the VELT and of the lifetime accumulated capital of a member. The external value or exchange rate is not present and is not applied. It is not possible for a member to exchange against another currency, this to prevent the wealthy of the earth from buying in or invading through investing. The VELT currency excludes a compensation of P&S working time is to be spent within the Society Aquapreneur. By definitive departure out of UTOPIA by ending its membership, the board can allow an exchange rate for its Velt currency

The Society Aquapreneur income is derived from VELT currency of membership fees and sales of P&S. Purchase of P&S outside the Society Aquapreneur for all non-self-produced life sustaining products and expansion comes from donations and balanced trade by the Society Aquapreneur.

Each member of the Society Aquapreneur is responsible for its own income, living expenses and pension. Not working = none Δ . **Each member is an independent entrepreneur and there is no employment relationship.** Each member is free to accept or refuse work from another member. Each member contributes free of charge to the running of Society Aquapreneur by contributing VELT and providing services.

8. The construction of the floating city.

The Society Aquapreneur organizes lectures "Plan B Floating City with Humancracy" with the aim of informing people about the possibilities to actually build floating elements that together form a City with a new form of government. The Society Aquapreneur is inextricably linked with the Humancracy with the Codex Homo Sapiens and with the Traject-hierarchy.

Everyone needs to help to make the construction possible. Anyone can contribute by not throwing away or destroying used products that float, but donating them. All floating objects can be used for the buoyancy of the foundation blocks and other construction parts.

The foundation can be made by linking sea containers together. Not only in one plane, but by placing multiple layers with each layer rotated 90 degrees. Extra strength is so obtained. Work buildings, houses, schools, museums, and parks, etc. can then be placed on this stable foundation. Each foundation is an element with a limited size and can be linked together to form a city.

The advantages of sea containers.

- Large numbers have already been produced (27 million).
- Used ones are cheap to buy.
- Easy to transport.
- Strong construction.

Disadvantages of shipping containers.

- There is no useful relation between width and length.
- The own weight.
- Limited lifespan.
- Dimensions are in Imperial feet.

There is a continuing well-functioning industrial production present to meet the growing demand for sea containers. Many products are transported to Western countries in sea containers and there is a number of surplus/shortage of empty and no longer certified for transport sea containers in Western countries. But there is worldwide a growing demand for new sea containers.

The sea containers are made in different lengths, heights and versions:

- High Cube Dry Cargo with doors.
- Standard Dry Cargo with doors.
- Bulk container
- Liquid tank
- Open top
- Flat Rack
- Platform
- Insulated with cooling

Sea containers are made of steel with a specially impregnated wooden floor and has its own weight. Special tools and a crane are necessary for every move. The lifespan of a sea container is 20 to 25 years depending on its use.

Sea containers are used all over the world not only for transport but also for all kinds of applications. Due to the large number, the price of used and not certified sea containers is fair and cheaper for many applications than to construct and build yourself.

Transport is possible by land on trucks, by rail and by water, both in inland shipping and on the seas. The containers are constructed in such a way that the cargo arrives undamaged. It is a very strong steel box and can withstand great external forces, and in addition they are also stackable in the same direction.

Because the entire transport world is set to sea containers with the Imperial dimensions, this is not a problem for them. However, if these sea containers will also be used for buildings it will be virtually impossible by the differed in length en width.

Sea containers as foundation blocks

The foundation blocks are time capsules that travel into the future. It is uncertain today how the future will develop and what the consequences will be from global warming and sea level rise. It is clear to all of us that the reversal of existing pollution such as CO₂ in the air and fossil energy conversion is very slow and difficult. Internationally set environmental proposals and goals are not met by the intended times. Economic interests are more dominant than the environment, only if money can be made from them initiatives will be taken.

In order to be able to use the sea containers as foundation blocks, the cooperation of everyone is necessary. It is the intention that an empty sea container is going to be filled with floatable objects. Sea containers are placed at multiple locations on land by members of the Society Aquapreneur and they manage the filling progress. Local residents can then return (at set times) used objects that can float. This mainly concerns cleaned and closed glass jars and bottles. Other floating objects will now no longer be thrown away or destroyed, but used as inclusions. It is also possible to enclose notes or drawings in the objects. Only non-compressible objects are suitable, if it can withstand at least 25 kg. of pressure, then it can be used.

The sea container is filled with the inclusions. For the gap filling, glue and reinforcements, for which will be used foam-lightweight concrete (that is extra filled with the EPS grains). This type of concrete is not intended for absorbing pressure loads, but only to fill the void spaces and to prevent the inclusions from moving. At the same time, this concrete will float and it gives the possibility to be removed with manual force in the distant future. Now the inclusions reappear and with the enclosed notes and drawings their intention or effect becomes clear. They are lovingly sent objects in the future that represent our society and make clear all the pros and cons to the new users.

To be able to couple the sea containers, an adapter is required that makes the bridging to a standard size of 2.5 meters. This 2.5 meter is closest to the sea container of its width 2.44 meter and different length dimensions.

Construction of the adapter

The length of the ladder adapter consists of multiples of 2.50 meters.

The Adapter width is 2.50 meters for all types, the addition to the container is only 6 cm in width, so 3 cm on both sides.

The height differs from 2.60 and 2.90 meters, so there must be two types of adapters that come to the same height.

The adapter is placed one at the bottom and one at the top of the sea container.

The total equal height has no relation to 2.50 meters of the width or length.

The adapter has four functions:

- To achieve the same height.
- To be able to place sea containers rotated 90 degrees on top of each other.
- Easily attached to each other with a coupling plate and coupling tube.
- Bring the weight to the connecting points.

The standard Twist Lock couplings on the market are exclusively intended for the attachment of sea containers during transport and not for other applications when placed at right angles to each other. The adapter is welded to the sea container and the standard Twist Lock holes are raised by the adapter and partly usable.

The height of the adapter follows from a solid construction of attachment to the sea containers and attachment to the other adapters both in the same direction next to it and the rotated 90 degrees placed sea containers on it.

The two adapters for the 2.60 meter container are each increased by an additional 15 cm to be level with the 2.90 meter container with the two adapters.

The two type of adapters that are different in height must be produced by the Society Aquapreneur.

The adapters enable the coupling between the containers by placing a coupling plate between them. The coupling plate comes at regular distances of 2.5 meter and can make the connection both horizontally and vertically.

The coupling plate is a flat thick steel plate with 4 holes around 50 mm for the coupling tube.

The locking is effected by a long steel tube that passes through the adapter and through each coupling plate. The coupling tube is a thick-walled galvanized steel standard 1 ½ "gas tube with an external diameter of 48.3 mm and can easily be passed through the adapter and the coupling plate without special tools.

The standard length of the coupling tube is sufficient for the coupling to be made in width. To use the coupling tubes in different lengths, they can be connected to each other. The threaded connector is welded into the end of the pipe and ensures that the pipe remains empty and only retains its own weight. The entire construction is intended to assemble containers as well as to be able to disassemble again!

It has been chosen to use this round standard gas pipe because this pipe is available worldwide. If a coupling tube cannot be removed because it is bent or broken, it can be drilled out.

The adapter plate on the adapter has a height of 100 mm with one 50 mm hole and is thick. This adapter plate is welded to the adapter that is the length of the number of 2.50 m units associated with each shipping container and also allows the attachment for welding the adapter plate in width. Two adapter plates are centred on the 2.5 meter units so that the coupling plate fits between these two adapter plates. The adapter is a ladder frame with adapter plates welded to it.

The coupling plate is now in front of the bottom two holes for the bottom two sea containers in the same direction with the adapters and coupling tube. This means that the other two holes remain available for two sea containers that can also be placed at right angles to them.

The construction of the side walls.

The weight of the load on the floor goes through the side rail to the lower corner blocks. All forces go exclusively to the four bottom corner blocks that hit only the ground because the bottom side and transverse rail is a 1/2 inch from the ground. On these blocks, the corner pillars are welded with the top block and with the lower and upper transverse joints and side rails. The corner pillars of thick sheet steel are internally reinforced with a U profile, creating a very strong pillar against bending. And the pillar can tolerate a large pressure load of 1+8 maximum loaded containers.

If containers are placed at right angles to each other, the weight of the top container must be transferred via the adapter to the lower container with its adapter. Each container is reinforced vertically in the side wall every 2.5 meters with a profile between the underside rail and the roof side rail. The difference distance between the rails above and below with the adapter is increased with a 1/2 inch steel plate. It creates four pillars in a 2.5 meter square. This makes this construction considerably sturdier than just stacking containers vertically.

The space created between the steel sides of the sea container and the standard dimensions of 2.5 meters in width and length are formed by the side, front (closed side), top and bottom. These are filled with seawater resistant concrete. At the rear (door side), to make the doors accessible, a wall with limited thickness of seawater-resistant concrete will be installed and unused space is filled with light / foam concrete, so that it can be broken open in the future.

The front and sides with corrugated plates are fitted with horizontally welded reinforcing bars or mats to ensure good adhesion of the concrete to the sea container. The seawater resistant concrete is at least 30 mm on the side and maximum with the depth of the trapezoid shape.

In order to obtain an optimal use of the foundation blocks, the concrete side walls will be used for placing images in relief text, as is known to us from Ancient Egypt, Persia, and Aztecs and many other ancient cultures. 9. Host Country Status separate

How to obtain a legal status with a worldwide recognition?

As example can serve the "Status Aparte" (Papiamentu language Dutch Caribbean). As a Dutchman, we are aware of the special status of former colonies. After the colonial era, the Netherlands contributed to the privatization of colonial land and islands. The status separate (Aparte) is a special status of the Caribbean part of the Kingdom of the Netherlands. The status separate include the:

- Foreign relations.
- Defence.
- Dutch nationality.

As a result there is one joint Minister of Foreign Affairs. The embassies, consulates and permanent representations abroad work for the Kingdom.

There is one joint Minister of Defence and operates in the Caribbean. Protection in the Caribbean is a task of the Dutch armed forces alone. The area has no NATO protection.

The treaties of the European Union have been signed by the Kingdom of the Netherlands, but have only been ratified for the European Netherlands. The Caribbean part has a different status.

In 1986 Aruba continued as a separate country within the Kingdom, in 2010 Sint Maarten and Curaçao followed. And Saba, Sint Eustatius and Bonaire were included as 'special municipalities' in the Caribbean Netherlands.

They have since been designated an area as The Netherlands Antilles encompass a six island territory:

The Leeward Antilles, off the coast of Venezuela (South America)

- Aruba, an autonomous country within the Kingdom of the Netherlands
- Bonaire, special municipality of the Netherlands
- Curaçao, an autonomous country within the Kingdom of the Netherlands

The Windward Islands, east of Puerto Rico

- Saba, special municipality of the Netherlands
- Sint Eustatius, special municipality of the Netherlands
- Sint Maarten, an autonomous country within the Kingdom of the Netherlands

The Netherlands Antilles also include some smaller islands:

Small Bonaire (island territory Bonaire)

Small Curaçao (island territory of Curaçao)

Green Island (island territory of Saba).

Guana Key, Hen & Chickens, Cow & Calf, Molly Beday and Pelikan Key (island area Sint Maarten)
